Emergency First Response

Duration: Two days (12 hours)

Designed for: Personnel who require training to enable them to administer basic Primary Care (CPR) and Secondary Care (First Aid) to injured or ill children (aged one to puberty) and infants (less than one year old).

Objectives:

- How to carry out primary assessments to deal with life threatening emergencies.
- How to carry out secondary assessments and to administer the latest first aid techniques.

Course Content:

- The role of the first aider.
- Scene assessment.
- Barrier use.
- Primary assessment.
- Rescue breathing.
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) – Infant and Child.

- Shock management.
- Spinal injury management.
- Obstructed Airway Management - Infant and Child.
- Bandaging.
- Burns and scalds.
- Injuries - cuts and scrapes, eye injuries, bites and stings.
- Specific illnesses - febrile convulsions, meningitis, sickle cell, poisoning, diabetes.
- Course questionnaire, evaluation and close.



This course will include group discussions and exercises, finally concluding with a multi-choice questionnaire.
